Almost 50 students received **Tools for the Trades scholarships** thanks to the LATTTC Foundation. Check out the link to the photos below. Congratulations to our student winners.



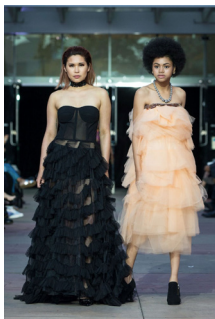
